We need you and your input.



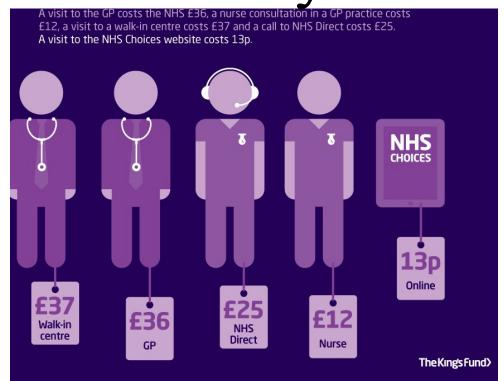
- We **need** your comments, ideas or criticisms [that is constructive criticisms] to know what is working well or to try and improve things.

Appointments

It is sometimes apparent that patients are not happy at the delays in getting their appointment on time. There really is no solution to this except to say, **try and be prepared for your own appointment** — write down what you want to know or to ask your GP.

The allotted appointment time is 10 minutes—will this be long enough? If necessary, book a double appointment if you need to discuss more than one condition.

IMPORTANT REQUEST— regarding Phlebotomy appointments

If you are unable to attend your appointment, PLEASE RING THE SURGERY TO CANCEL IT.

Please do not just not turn up. The Phlebotomy system is very stretched at present and the practice are under threat of having their Phlebotomy appointments allowance cut, due to the high volume of people not showing up for their appointments. This important service is not one we would want to lose at the Warrens and it is just common courtesy to call and cancel if you are unable to attend the appointment. Another patient could have that appointment !!!

For those of you with internet access - don't forget you can book your appointments and order your repeat prescriptions online via the surgery's website. You will need to obtain a registration letter from the receptionists which will contain your pin and access codes. Follow the online instructions and away you go!!
